

# Safety Reminder

## CIRCLE FOR SAFETY/SECURE LOAD

Circle for Safety has been around for many years. The majority of our drivers follow the simple steps to insure that it is safe to move a vehicle. Not only are you looking for other people that might be hurt when the vehicle is moved, but you are making sure that your vehicle is secured and ready for travel, GETTING THE BIG PICTURE.

IS YOUR TRUCK READY TO TRAVEL? Are the materials and tools that you carry properly placed and tied down so they will not fall or bounce from the truck and cause damage to the public and have to be replaced? Are the bin doors properly latched and closed. You are responsible for the securing of material and tools on the truck you operate. You are responsible for inspecting that unit prior to taking it out of the yard/job site and when returning at the end of the day or shift. If anything falls off the truck, whether it is a 10" bolt, washer, photo cell, crossarm, transformer or a #2 kearney, you, as the driver are responsible and will have to answer for the damage that those pieces may cause.

REMEMBER, if you must delay in leaving once you have finished your work on site, STOP, and complete another Circle for Safety. It is a few moments that could save a life.
